Ice & Severe Weather

As we move into the colder and darker days, please remember that your child needs a warm, waterproof coat with them. We would also recommend "layering" up their clothing to help as the temperature changes with activities.

Now that we appear to be in for a period of cold and icy weather, please be advised that we will endeavour to clear at least one pathway - either by gritting, or when necessary of snow. It is not possible to grit/clear all areas due to time-lines and staffing.

Please take care, as you would in any other public areas, whilst on school property, there will possibly be untreated areas.

Should we encounter any severe weather, please remember to check your Parentmail before school - if there are any pathways we are unable to make safe first thing in the morning, we will notify you with details of particular areas and therefore gateways which may be closed. We will always endeavour to advise of designated entries into school before you leave home.

Schools will only be closed as a last resort, should there be insufficient staff able to reach the school or it is deemed too dangerous to travel. In this event, work will be set on our usual platforms - Purple Mash, Seesaw and Tapestry.
