We are revisiting lots of our science this half term and investigating science through a range of stories. One of those stories is The Oak Tree by Julia Donaldson.

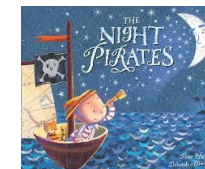
