

English

We'll read a variety of texts - Billy's Bucket, Pirate Pete, The Night Pirates. We'll use mapping to organise and recall key events. We'll use Pie Corbett storytelling words and actions to inspire our writing. We'll identify key features of an information (non-fiction) book. We'll ask - What is like at the Seaside? What were seaside holidays like in the past? We'll research & present information about Blackbeard the pirate.

History

We'll ask and answer our BIG question "How have explorers changed the world?" We'll investigate which parts of the world were explored, before comparing exploration in the past with exploration today.

PSHE

Our SCARF units are "Being My Best" & "Growing and Changing". We'll continue to think about ROCK - Respect, Openness, Confidentiality & Kindness.

Geography

We'll ask and answer our BIG question "What is the weather like in the UK?" We'll investigate the UK's hot & cold places using weather maps with a simple key.

In our Coding Unit we'll develop an understanding of instructions, logic & sequences. We'll also focus on Spreadsheets and Technology outside School
