Enjoy talking about your book and answering questions. <u>Dan't</u> forget to complete and return your Reading Challenge Slip every Manday - house points, raffle tickets and class prizes are available.



<u>Phonics/Spelling practise</u> - Every Friday, take a look at the challenge your teachers have set on Purple Mash - you might like to give this a try. We can't wait to see how you get on!
