

English

We will read fiction and non-fiction books about London. We'll use The Write Stuff sentence stacking & mapping to create our own diary entries. We also will create information texts about The Great Fire of London. We'll enjoy sharing our page turners all about Paddington as we get to learn all about his London adventures.

Science

As part of unit "Uses of Everyday Materials" we'll investigate why certain materials are used for specific jobs, learn about everyday uses of some materials & discover that materials can occur naturally or be manufactured.

Maths

We will read, write and order numbers up to 100 and investigate place value. We will practise simple addition, subtraction, doubling & halving problems. We will start to learn about column addition and subtraction. We'll investigate names and properties of 2d and 3d shapes. We'll continue to complete our BMBT & CLIC weekly challenges.

History

We'll observe & handle different sources of evidence to ask and answer basic questions about the past. We will key events linked to The Great Fire of London and use new information to compare now and then.

Year 2- Autumn Term

Geography- What is it like to live by the coast?

We'll investigate places, using maps & globes to identify the UK & its countries. We will also learn to name the seas and oceans surrounding the UK. We'll talk about our local coast and compare this to other coasts.

Art

We'll describe & appraise the work of notable artists, Bridget Riley & Henri Matisse. We will use their artwork as inspiration to create sketches and collages.

Design Technology

We'll design, make & evaluate a moving picture of London including flaps, sliders and pivot levers. In Food Technology we'll follow a recipe and make bread rolls.

We will be learning about 'Me & My Relationships' and 'Valuing Difference' using CORAM Education's SCARF programme.

ICT

We'll focus on the Purple Mash units Coding, Online Safety & Effective Searching. We'll use iPads to support our learning.

Music

Charanga Units - Pulse/Rhythm & Pitch - Hands, Feet, Heart (South African) / Bubushka. (Listening, Appraising, Performing & Composing) We will sing a variety of songs about London.

PE

We will explore & repeat basic skills, actions as part of Gymnastics Unit. We will play simple team games.
