Our Topic: Enchanting Egyptians

Our learning this half term:

- To continue to follow our progression in maths, developing place value, calculation and reasoning skills.
- Recall and use the multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. .
- Immersing ourselves in our chosen texts: Egyptian Cinderella, Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx and The Magic Paintbrush.
- Writing reports and diaries of events in the Ancient Egyptian times
- Writing persuasive letters, diary writing and a story adaptation
- Learning about the importance of the River Nile
- Identifying the positions of countries on a map of the world
- Learning about light and shadows
- Exploring and increasingly use the French language in simple conversation
- Look at composition of songs and perform and respond to music
- Learning about what life was like in Ancient Egyptian times

- Handwriting - letter formation / fluent cursive script.

- Grammar - to develop using fronted adverbials, subordinate clauses, and paragraphing.
