English

We'll read some Traditional Tales including The Little Red Hen, & use Pie Corbett/Story mapping & retelling to organise key events in stories. We'll use a variety of writing styles to create fiction & non-fiction pieces of work linked to our topic. We'll share our pageturner "James and the Giant Peach" by Roald Dahl.

Science

'Comparing Animals' - we'll recognise common characteristics & physical features, make comparisons & classify animals. We'll collect data. "Plants" we'll name a variety of common wild & garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We'll name plant parts & draw & label diagrams of flowers. We'll investigate if beans need water for growth & identify edible plant parts.

We'll count to & across 100, forwards & backwards & count in 2s, 5s & 10s. We'll solve addition & subtraction problems involving numbers up to 20 & beyond. Problems will be represented with numbers & symbols (+, - and =). We will be measuring length/height, mass/weight, capacity/volume using non-standard & standard units of measure. We'll continue to practise correct number formation. We'll investigate 2D/3D shapes & their properties. We'll continue to practise our BMBT and CLIC challenges.

History

We'll look at personal chronology, find out about the past within living memory, examine photographs & ask questions. We'll look at simple timelines extending back to before we were born.

Geography We'll use maps to continents, recognise oceans & countries outside the UK with a focus on Africa. We'll identify physical features of Kenya using aerial photographs & maps before identifying human features, exploring land-use. We'll make simple maps using data collected through lieldwork.
