Our learning this half term:

- To continue to follow our White Rose & BMBT/CLIC Maths schemes.
- Investigating statistics - Interpreting & constructing simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams & simple tables; asking & answering simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category & sorting the categories by quantity.
- Using mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction & movement, including movement in a straight line & distinguishing between rotation as a turn & in terms of right angles for quarter, half & three-quarter turns (clockwise and anticlockwise)
- Immersing ourselves in our chosen texts - The Very Lazy Ladybird, The Very Quiet Cricket, The Very Busy Spider, The Bad-Tempered Ladybird & The Enchanted Wood by Roald Dahl.
- Planning & writing our own stories about Minibeasts.
- Writing non chronological reports about Minibeasts with headings & key vocabulary.
- Learning about "Microhabitats"; identifying, naming & sorting Minibeasts into groups according to certain criteria.
- Finding out "How did we learn to fly?" by looking at significant events in the history of flight on a timeline.
- Asking "Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place?"; learning about climate zones & mapping out hot & cold places globally.
- Investigating hand puppets; designing, making & evaluating our own hand puppets using simple joining and sewing techniques.

Ongoing learning:

- Individual and shared reading sessions
- Daily Phonics / Grammar sessions
- Learning CEWs during Precision Spelling Sessions
- Handwriting - using correct, cursive letter formation; joining all letters all the time.
- Learn 2x, 5x, 10x 3x and 4x tables off by heart.
- Writing sentences independently using CL, FS ? or ! Use of subordination and co-ordination to extend sentences. Using a variety of suffixes in writing including -ly, -ment, -ness, -ful.
