

## English

We'll read a variety of texts - Billy's Bucket, Pirate Pete, The Night Pirates. We'll use mapping to organise and recall key events. We'll use The Write Stuff Unit "Grandad's Island" to inspire our writing. We'll identify key features of an information (non-fiction) book. We'll ask - What is like at the Seaside? What were seaside holidays like in the past? We'll research & present information about Blackbeard the pirate.

## History

We will understand chronology & arrange events in order on a timeline. We'll build an overview of world history & describe significant people from the past. We'll learn about Blackbeard the Pirate!

## PSHE

Our SCARF units are "Being My Best" & "Growing and Changing". We'll continue to think about ROCK - Respect, Openness, Confidentiality & Kindness.

## Geography

We'll create and plot features to create our own maps of Felixstowe as well as Pirate Treasure Maps. We'll ask & answer geographical questions to find out what Felixstowe looks like

## ICT

We'll use I pads. In our Coding Unit we'll develop an understanding of instructions, logic & sequences. We'll also focus on Spreadsheets and Tech outside School

### Forces and Movement:

We'll observe & describe how things move, using simple comparisons such as faster and slower.
