Our Topics: How have children's lives changed? Where does our food come from?

Our learning this half term:

- To develop calculation strategies for $\times$ and $\div$
- To continue to develop reasoning and problem solving skills.
- To learn to calculate area.
- To enjoy excerpts from a range of texts.
- To write in a range of genres including; a playscript and explanation.
- To explore the role of the digestive system and compare teeth and diets of different animals as part of a food chain.
- To continue to explore the use of French language in simple conversation.
- To develop historical skills, researching using a range of sources to find out how children's lives changed.
- To develop mapping skills, researching where food is imported from and the importance of trading responsibly.
- Your child will learn to play a brass instrument on Thursday afternoon.

Ongoing learning:

- Individual and guided reading sessions
- Learning common word spellings
- Handwriting - letter formation / fluent cursive script.
- Multiplication; times tables learning up to 12x table
- Grammar - to develop sentence structure and increase vocabulary using a range of grammatical structures.
