Our BIQ question:


<u>What are the key features of our beach?</u>

Our learning this half term:

- To continue to follow our White Rose Maths scheme.
- Comparing, reading, writing, ordering numbers to 100 and beyond.
- Solving multiplication and division problems and representing work with numbers, pictures and symbols. Immersing ourselves in our chosen texts -Billy's Bucket by Kes Gray and a variety of Seaside Poems.
- Using Pie Corbett storytelling words and actions, and mapping to retell stories.
- Learning about "Forces & Space: Seasonal Changes"; discussing the four seasons & the weather associated with each.
- Asking "What is the weather like in the UK?" & investigating the UK's hot & cold places using weather maps with a simple key.
- Asking "How have explorers changed the world?" & • investigating which parts of the world were explored, before comparing exploration in the past with exploration today.
- Studying the work of the artists Richard Long & Andy Goldsworthy & using this to inspire our paintings and drawings.

Ongoing learning:

- Individual and shared reading sessions
- Daily Phonics sessions
- Learning weekly spellings
- Handwriting using correct cursive letter formation & joining letters.
- Learn number bonds of 10 off by heart. Forming all numbers correctly.
- Writing simple sentences independently. Including finger spaces between words. Using CLs and FS correctly. Using the joining words "and" "because"
